## Riddle Hangman

## Materials needed:

- White boards/dry erase markers/erasers for each player.

To Play:
(If you don't know how to play "hangman" - use the QR code for a quick video tutorial. )
$1^{\text {st }}$ Player draws a puzzle card. This is the puzzle they will work on for the first round.

How to Play Hangman


Then the player draws and works a problem card.
When players answer their problem cards correctly, they can guess a letter on the puzzle card. If they guess correctly, fill in all of the times that letter appears on the puzzle card, and guess again. If they guess incorrectly they get a piece added to their hangman and they have to solve another problem card to keep guessing. Keep track of letters guessed and "hangman" on white board. Once at least 3 letters have been filled in on the puzzle card, the player can start attempting to guess the answer to the puzzle.

To win: Solve the puzzle before your person is "hung" by the hangman.
Printing: 2-sided, black and white, flip on short side. Laminate to re-use.
