## Rules for "Two Hundred"

Object of the Game: Players compare the totals of their "Oh Yeah!" Dominos. The player with the total closest to 200 (over or under) wins.

Step 1: Turn all dominos face down.
Step 2: Player 1 flips up a domino and decide which number is "tens" and which is "ones."

Step 3: Player one decides whether to place this domino on the "No way!" or "Oh Yeah!" side of their board. Note: Once a

$$ domino has been placed, it CANNOT be moved.

Step 4: Player two takes their turn and flips up their first domino.

Step 5: Players alternate flipping up dominos, and choosing where to place them until all 12 spaces have been filled on both player's boards.

Step 6: Each player adds up the dominos on his/her "Oh Yeah!" side.
Winner: The player with the total closest to 200 wins.
